SECOND ROUND DISTRIBUTION FOR SUBSIDIZED FARE PROGRAM

Casper, WY February 28, 2018: The second round distribution for the Subsidized Fare Program will start on Wednesday, February 28, 2018 @ 1715 East 4th Street from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The funding for this program is made possible via a Community Development Block Grant through Housing and Community Development in the City of Casper. The funding is designated for individuals who are considered very low, low, to moderate income residing in the City of Casper. Mills and Evansville provide subsidy funding for those low income individuals residing in their communities. The program provides bus tokens and/or CATC tickets at no charge to assist with some of the transportation needs of this population.

CATC and/or The Bus passengers who have an application on file will come to 1715 East 4th Street to sign a voucher to receive 50 Bus tokens or 15 CATC tickets. The proof of income is on file as well.

Applicants who have not filled out an application are required to come to 1715 East 4th Street complete the application and provide proof of income such as a food stamp card or payroll check stub or SSDI letter. If they qualify they will receive tokens or tickets.

The funding will be completely expended after the second round is complete. Funding for next year is unknown at this time.
